




Song Profile

Monty Roberts owns a horse <u>ranch(</u>大牧场) in San Francisco. He is willing to help the young who want to <u>pursue</u> their <u>dreams</u>. We are always curious about the reason behind and one day he told us his story.

When Monty was young, he was the son of an itinerant (游荡的) horse trainer who would go from stable to stable, race track to race track, farm to farm and ranch to ranch, training horses. As a result, his high school career was continually interrupted. When he was a senior, he was asked to write a paper about what he wanted to be and do when he grew up. .

He put a great deal of his heart into the project and the next day he handed it in to the <u>teacher</u>. Two days later he received his paper back. On the front was a large red F with a <u>note</u> that read, "See me after class."

The teacher said, "This is an unrealistic dream for a young boy like you. You have no money. You come from an itinerant family. You have no <u>resources</u>. Owning a horse ranch requires a lot of money. You have to buy the land. You have to pay for the original breeding stock and later you'll have to pay large stud (马群) fees.
