"So weird!" said Ava. "You do things really differently than we did at my old dojo (柔道馆).



2. Read for the theme.

Clue 1: conflict—solution—theme (积极向上的, 富有正能量的)

Clue 2: pay attention to the 10 underlined words (esp. the positive abstract words may have a hint for the theme)

silent, explained, hoped

TIP 3: The possible theme can be inferred by the above 2 clues!
