W: Welcome to ABC electronics. First, let me go over what we do in the department during a typical workday. We basically work from 8:30 to 5:30 with an hour-long lunch break from 12 to 1, although we do expect you to do a little overtime if there's something important to do. The lunch break is flexible. You can go a little earlier or a little later if you prefer. The main thing is that all our work must be completed on schedule. We even allow our employees to go home early if they finish their work early. You should attend a department meeting every Monday morning. There are other meetings for people working together on certain projects. Department heads also attend an interdepartmental meeting every two weeks. At first, you'll be responsible to me. Later, you'll be working more independently. Salaries are paid directly into your bank account, so make sure you give the accounts department all your bank account details as soon as possible.
