language was to help storytellers remember the plot of the stories, in the

Ramayana. Early poets 25 Homer wrote pieces about
famous heroes, pleasant adventures, and important places. These days,
plenty of poetry is about more ordinary things. There are famous poems

physics. Most poetry 27 rhymes, or follows a specific
syllable structure. Haikus, for instance, have five syllables in their first
and third line, and seven in the second. Couplets are two lines

English-language poetry usually doesn't rhyme at all, instead relying on
the platform of short broken up lines and plain language 29
(paint) a picture. One of the pioneers of this style of 'free verse' poetry
was Walt Whitman. Poets plan the structure they'll use based on the
subject of their poem. Some people think it's a pity that poems don't
rhyme any more, and 30 poetry was much harder to write
when it had more rules.
