W: No, I don't. I can't swim. I'm scared of being in the water.

M: OK. You know, we offer lessons here.

W: I know. But I'm just too scared.

M: Well, I'm sure our trainer can help you.

Text 7

W: Hi, I have a reservation under the name Sally.

M: Hi, Sally. A room for 12 people at 7:30 p.m., is that right? (8)

W: Yes. We've got two more people coming, though. (8) Is that OK?

M: No problem. Your room can easily fit(容纳) as many as 16 people.

W: Perfect! Thanks. Can I have a look at the menu while I wait for my friends?

M: Of course! May I ask when your friends will be arriving?

W: I'm sure most of them will arrive on time. I got here early because I wanted to arrange the food in advance. (9)

M: I see. Here is the menu.

W: Thank you very much.

Text 8

M: How was your first week in China, Linda? (10) (11) (12)

W: It was great! My local friends took me to a restaurant for dinner last night near my hotel. (10)

M: Cool! How was that?

W: I really enjoyed it. It was my first Chinese dining experience. (11)

M: Yeah? Didn't you have Chinese food before in the United States?

W: Oh, of course I did, but none of them was very authentic. (11)

M: I see. Anyway, so you were familiar with chopsticks already, right?

W: Yes. But I learned about other traditional dining rules in China last night.

M: Such as?

W: Well, for example, Chinese people share all the dishes at the dinner table. (12)

M: Don't you do that in America?

W: No. Usually everybody gets their own plate of food in America.

21. C。态度观点题。根据第二段的内容可知，作者因为洗澡水的问题感到有些失望，选 C。

22. D。推理判断题。根据第五段中的 *She has no idea that she is poor* 可推断，作者很同情这个可爱但却贫穷的小女孩，选 D。

23. B。推理判断题。根据最后一段中的最后两句 *While bathing, I thought of this simple pleasure. Clean water wasn't my right; it was luck* 可推断出，作者明白了生活中的快乐并不是我们的权利，而是我们有幸得到的东西，应当珍惜，选 B。

24. A。细节理解题。根据第三段可知，大量游客涌来，带动本地经济的增长。

25. D。根据第四段 *In mid-July, record temperatures were recorded near the North Pole.*

26. D。细节理解。根据最后一个自然段首句与末句及倒数第二段中的 *... In mid-July, record temperatures were recorded near the North Pole.* 可知。

C

本文的语篇类型是议论文，主题语境为人与自我。人们都认为确立明确的目标很重要，但你有想过它的局限性呢？

27. A。推理判断题。根据第二段中的两个问句可知，设定目标忽视了我们生活中会发生的变化，所以这其实是在预测不可预测的未来。

28. B。词义猜测题。根据该划线词所在句中的 *... so that you often forget that other things in your life can also add just as much joy to your experience* 可知，设定目标会让我们把开心与满足局限在这一个目标上，而忘了还有一些别的事也能带给我们同样的愉悦。

29. C。细节理解题。根据第五段的内容可知，追求趣味性能让我们有意外的收获。

30. B。写作意图题。通读全文可知，本文作者从一个新的视角理解目标设定。

32. 此处应该是标题类。答案 A 是全段的主旨大意。

33. 选项 B Don't be influenced by others' interests.与后一句有明显的因果关系，要关心自己真正要什么，不要被他人影响。

34. 本段大意是关于预算开支，所以 F 符合上下文。

35. 上下信息中提到 children 和 family 属于同源词。信息有最大地相关性。

36. D. 根据本空后的 In order to move on in life 以及下文内容可知，经历改变可以教会我们关于生活的知识。

37. C. 为了在人生中前行，我们必须适应改变。

38. D. 此处与本空前的 accept it 形成对比。我们要么接受改变，要么与之抗争。

39. A. 根据下文内容，尤其是最后一段中的 I choose to accept it gladly 可知，作者选择微笑面对。

40. B. 根据本空后的 things in my primary school 可知，作者以为上初中后，一切事情和小学时是一样的。

41. B. 然而一开学，作者就意识到这不是真的。

42. A. 根据本空后的 my old group of friends 可知，上了初中后，作者有了更多的课业，也结交了新朋友。

43. C. 根据本空前的 split up 可知，几个月后，作者意识到自己应该接受现实：我们都在经历巨大的变化，分开也是可行的。

48. C. 根据第 52 空后的 she put no effort into it 可知，此处指的是付出的努力。

应用文评分原则：

1. 本题总分为 15 分，按 4 个档次给分。
2. 评分时，先根据文章的内容和语言质量初步确定其档次，然后以该档次的要求来衡量，确定或调整档次，最后给分。
3. 评分时应考虑：内容是否完整，条理是否清楚，交际是否得体，语言是否准确。
4. 拼写、标点符号或书写影响内容表达时，应视其影响程度予以考虑。英、美拼写及词汇用法均可接受。
5. 词数少于 60，酌情减分。

各档次的给分范围和要求：

第一档（13 分～15 分）

完全完成了试题规定的任务。

- 内容完整，条理清楚；
- 交际得体，表达时充分考虑到了交际对象的需求；体现出较强的语言运用能力。

完全达到了预期的写作目的。

第二档（9 分～12 分）

基本完成了试题规定的任务。

- 内容、条理和交际等方面基本符合要求；
- 所用语法和词汇满足了任务的要求；
- 语法或用词方面有一些错误，但不影响理解。

基本达到了预期的写作目的。

第三档（4 分～8 分）

未恰当完成试题规定的任务。

- 内容不完整；

- 未能清楚地传达信息。

第四档（1 分～3 分）

未完成试题规定的任务。

- 写了少量相关信息；
- 语法或用词方面错误较多，严重影响了对写作内容的理解。
