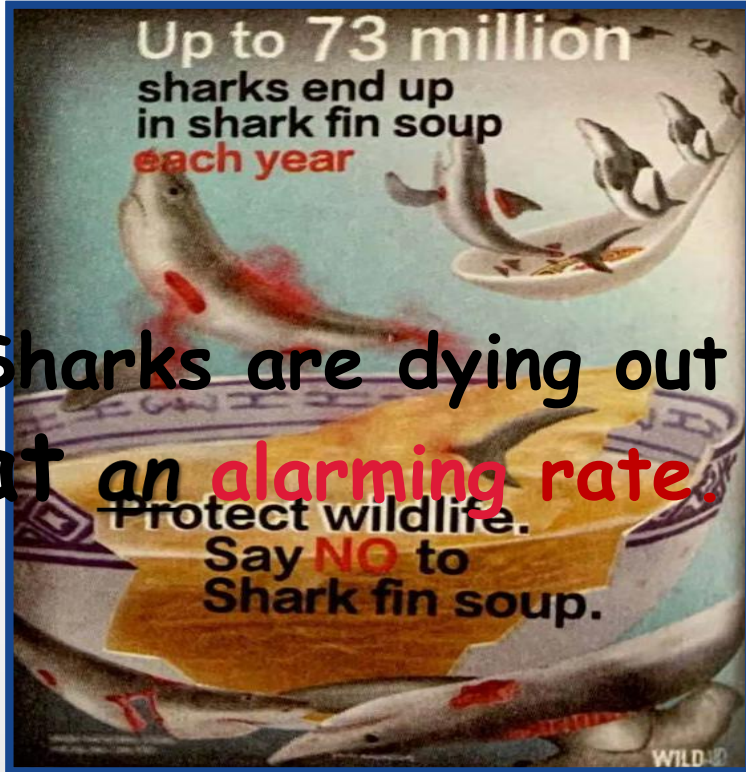

top: 150-200 wildlife species lost  
down: "bleeding clock" position  
down: lost falling down with some wildlife  
dead sharks without under the clock  
at the bottom (**extinct** wildlife)  
◆ background: every 24 hours
