


心理因素学生在进行听力练习或考试时往 往表现为听音时感到紧张、焦虑因而导致 无法正常听音。

缺乏背景知识由于没有语言环境,学生很 少了解听力材料中的背景知识,无法做出 正确的判断、推理、猜测。

学生缺乏听力解题技巧研究发现,很多情况 下由于听者未能掌握相关的听力技巧,因而 不能很好地理解听力材料。

词汇储备不足一个学生的听、说、读、写要 达到一定的水平,必须拥有相应数量的必备 词汇。 在听力理解的过程中, 语 音是第一位的, 听者首先 接受的是语音信息,大脑 接受了因素, 音节, 中音 等因素构成的单词,短语 和句子后使他们在自己的 语言图式中"对号入座", 根据已有的知识结构(图 式),开始对该信息进行建 构、以理解其意义。







1, "辅音+元音"型连读(异性相吸)
 如: I'd li<u>ke a</u>nother bow<u>l</u> of rice.
 2、"辅音+半元音"型连读英语语音中的/j/
 和/w/是半元音,如果前一个词是以辅音结尾,后一个词是以半元音,特别是/j/开头,此时也要连读。Than<u>k y</u>ou.
