# 一、评分原则

  - (3) 上下文的连贯性;
  - (4) 对各要点表达的独立性情况。
- 5. 拼写与标点符号是语言准确性的一个重要方面,评分时,应视其对交际的影响程度予以考虑。
- 6. 如书写较差以致影响交际,可将分数降低一个档次。
