【语篇导读】本文是应用文，介绍了大都会博物馆的活动。

21. C 细节理解题。根据第三个活动介绍第一句中的 "through virtual introductions to core themes" 可知答案。故选 C。
22. D 细节理解题。根据第一个活动中的 "...experience the newest exhibitions at the Met without the crowds. Members are also invited to bring guest(s)." 可知，会员可以在开门之前避开人群参观，还可以带上其他的人。故选 D。
23. B 细节理解题。根据第二个活动第二句的 "Join us every Tuesday for picture-book

readings”可知答案。故选 B。

【语篇导读】本文是记叙文。讲述了作者对书店的喜爱。

24. A 词句猜测题。作者在本段中主要强调在 90 年代的时候，到处都是书店。当时甚至都没有 Amazon 购物网站。故选 A。
25. D 细节理解题。根据第三段可知她和丈夫约会时先去买咖啡再去逛书店，最后一句也说边喝咖啡边阅读书里最喜欢的段落。故选 D。
26. B 细节理解题。根据倒数第二段第二句“Friends described the feeling of discovery and exploration, the calming serenity of being surrounded by words and ideas.”可知答案。故选 B。
27. A 主旨大意题。本文主要讲述了作者对书店的喜爱。故选 A。

C

【语篇导读】本文是议论文。分析了人们为什么不想回到办公室上班以及远程工作的问题。

28. C 细节理解题。根据第二段第一句中的“Though seen as a necessity during the pandemic”可知，在疫情严重的时期，远程办公是有必要的。故选 C。
29. A 细节理解题。根据第二段第三句中的“the key drivers for performance and productivity”以及第四句中的“which calls for maximizing efficiency”可知，公司想让员工回到公司上班是为了提高效率。故选 A。
30. C 推理判断题。根据最后一段内容可知，作者在作决策的时候，还是应该优先考虑公司的利益。因为“有了大家才会有小家”。故选 C。
31. A 主旨大意题。全文介绍了当前人们远程上班的一些问题以及公司对提高效率的希望，因此 A 选项“完全在家办公的日子可能要结束”正确。故选 A。

32. B 细节理解题。根据第二段第三句中的“it's nowhere to be seen”可知答案。故选 B。
33. B 主旨大意题。第四段主要介绍了科学家们是如何进行研究的。故选 B。
34. C 细节理解题。根据第五段第二句“So far the device has found...nothing.”可知答案。故选 C。
35. D 推理判断题。根据倒数第二段中 Kevin Lesko 所说的“You don't go into rare search physics without some hope of finding something.”可知，如果我们有希望，总会有所发

现。故选 D。

第二节

【语篇导读】本文是说明文。介绍了如何泡茶品茶。

36. F 根据前文中的“**all the tools**”以及后文中的“**get hold of one**”可知，前文中在介绍获得茶具。故选 F。
37. D 本段介绍如何准备茶具以品茶的外观和香味。前文提到要将茶壶和茶杯放碗里，后文介绍将茶杯传递给其他人品味。因此此处需要说明中间的步骤。故选 D。
38. B 本段介绍泡茶的步骤，其中提到“理想的温度”，所以段落标题应该是 B。
39. G 前文介绍了泡茶所有的步骤，而品茶之前的最后一步就是要“泡”茶。故选 G。
40. C 根据后文提示可知本句是对如何品茶的总结。故选 C。

42. D 当妈妈听到这些话的时候突然就心生爱意，心里暖暖的。故选 D。
43. B 作者接下来就要介绍 Jensen Weiss 的情况。故选 B。
44. D 最近妈妈又将去年发布过的帖子重新发布了一次。故选 D。
45. C 根据前文中的“**You cleaned my room**”可知，妈妈帮孩子打扫了房间，孩子对她表示感谢。故选 C。
46. B 这个视频被发布之后，有很多人点赞。故选 B。
47. A 妈妈在打扫房间的时候，这个两岁的孩子正在外面和爸爸一起玩耍。故选 A。
48. C 妈妈听到孩子跑进来的时候，就感觉到孩子会说一些感人的话。故选 C。
49. B 应粉丝的要求，这位妈妈最近重发了这个视频，就是要向更多的人传递这样的快乐时刻。故选 B。
50. D 根据后文的“**including mental health issues**”可知，她面临了很多的困难。故选 D。

54. B 根据句中的“**love themselves more than anything**”可知妈妈让孩子不要受外界因素影响。故选 B。

55. D 本文讲述了妈妈和孩子的故事。故选 D。

57. arrival 考查名词。分析句子成分可知，此处需要名词作 after 的宾语。

58. for 考查介词。for 后接时间段表示持续时间的长短。

59. herself 考查代词。主语和宾语一致时，使用反身代词。

60. hoping 考查非谓语动词。本题考查“with+宾语+宾补”结构。

61. was placed 考查谓语动词。place 在定语从句中作谓语，与主语 Rowdy 为被动关系。

62. accidentally 考查副词。分析句子成分可知，accidentally 修饰动词 fall。

63. but 考查连词。根据句意可知，虽然他们努力去追，但是没有成功。

64. A 考查冠词。主语 operation 为单数可数名词，必须用冠词。

65. where 考查定语从句。先行词 an area 在从句中作地点状语，用关系副词 where。
