



Yawning and turning your back to others can often be misread when you do not mean it.



Body language is the <u>unspoken</u> part of communication that we use to show our true feelings and emotions, such as amusement, pleasure, anger, and boredom. It includes our posture, our facial expressions, and our hand gestures. When we are able to "read" these signs, we can use it to our advantage. For example, if someone turns his back to you when you are talking, it is likely to mean that he is bored and not interested in your speech. Being aware of these signs can help you to adjust what you say and how you say it, so you can make him feel more at ease and more interested in your talk. However, it should be noted that body language is not international. Misunderstandings can happen if you make the same gesture in a different country.
