第 II 卷（非选择题 共 55 分）

第一节 应用文写作（满分 15 分）

一、评分原则

1. 范文仅供参考，学生可用不同语言表达形式来表述要点。

2. 本题总分为 15 分，按 5 个档次给分。

从内容（要点是否齐全）、语言（词汇丰富性和语法正确性）和交际（得体性和合理性）三个方面综合评判作文的档次。先定档，后给分。

3. 评分时，先根据文章的内容和语言初步确定其所属档次，然后以该档次的要求来衡量、确定或调整档次，最后给分。

4. 词数少于 60 和多于 100 的，从总分中减去 2 分。

5. 拼写与标点符号是语言准确性的一个方面，评分时，应视其对交际的影响程度予以考虑。英、美拼写及词汇用法均可接受。

6. 如书写较差，以至于影响交际，将分数降低一个档次。

二、各档次的给分范围和要求

第五档 (13-15)	完全完成了试题规定的任务。 —覆盖所有内容要点。 —应用了较多的语法结构和词汇。 —语法结构或词汇方面有些许错误，但为尽力使用较复杂结构或较高级词汇所致；具备较强的语言运用能力。 —有效地使用了语句间的连接成分，使全文结构紧凑。 完全达到了预期的写作目的。
第四档 (10-12)	完全完成了试题规定的任务。 —虽漏掉 1、2 个次重点，但覆盖所有主要内容。 —应用的语法结构和词汇能满足任务的要求。

第二档 (4-6)	<p>未适当完成试题规定的任务。</p> <p>—漏掉或未描述清楚一些主要内容，写了一些无关内容。</p> <p>—语法结构单调，词汇项目有限。</p> <p>—有一些语法结构或词汇方面的错误，影响了对写作内容的理解。</p> <p>—较少使用语句间的连接成分，内容缺少连贯性。</p> <p>信息未能清楚地传达给读者。</p>
第一档 (1-3)	<p>未完成试题规定的任务。</p> <p>—明显遗漏主要内容，写了一些无关内容，原因可能是未理解试题要求。</p> <p>—语法结构单调，词汇项目有限。</p> <p>—较多语法结构或词汇方面的错误，影响对写作内容的理解。</p> <p>—缺乏语句间的连接成分，内容缺少连贯性。</p> <p>信息未能传达给读者。</p>

三、该题具体要求：

(一) 内容要点：

1. 回顾过往；
2. 表示感谢；
3. 表达祝愿。

(二) 应用词汇和语法结构的情况：

1. 时态以一般过去时和一般现在时为主；
2. 使用与主题相关的词汇；
3. 能够使用恰当的语法结构。

(三) 上下文的连贯性

按照内容要点展开写作，使用恰当的连接词或表达法使文章内容连贯。

One possible version:

第二节 读后续写 (满分 25 分)

各档次的给分范围和要求

档次	描述
第七档 (22-25 分)	—创造了丰富、合理的内容, 富有逻辑性, 续写完整, 与原文情境融洽度高; —使用了多样且恰当的词汇和语法结构, 表达流畅, 语言错误很少, 且完全不影响理解; —自然有效地使用了段落间、句间衔接手段, 全文结构清晰, 前后呼应, 意义连贯。
第六档 (18-21 分)	—创造了比较丰富、合理的内容, 比较有逻辑性, 续写比较完整, 与原文情境融洽度较高; —使用了比较多样且恰当的词汇和语法结构, 表达比较流畅, 有个别错误, 但不影响理解; —比较有效地使用了语句间衔接手段, 全文结构比较清晰, 意义比较连贯。
第五档 (15-17 分)	—创造了基本合理的内容, 有一定的逻辑性, 续写基本完整, 与原文情境相关; —使用了比较恰当的词汇和语法结构, 表达方式不够多样性, 表达有些许错误, 但基本不影响理解; —使用了语句间衔接手段, 全文结构比较清晰, 意义比较连贯。
第四档 (11-14 分)	—创造了基本完整的故事内容, 但有的情节不够合理或逻辑性不强, 与原文情境基本相关; —使用了简单的词汇和语法结构, 有部分语言错误和不恰当之处, 个别部分影响理解; —尚有语句衔接的意识, 全文结构基本清晰, 意义基本连贯。
第三档 (6-10 分)	—内容和逻辑上有一些重大问题, 续写不够完整, 与原文有一定程度脱节; —所用的词汇有限, 语法结构单调, 错误较多且比较低级, 影响理解; —未能有效地使用语句间衔接手段, 全文结构不够清晰, 意义欠连贯。
第二档 (1-5 分)	—内容和逻辑上有较多重大问题, 或有部分内容抄自原文, 续写不完整, 与原文情境基本脱节; —所使用的词汇非常有限, 语法结构单调, 错误极多, 严重影响理解; —几乎没有使用语句间衔接手段, 全文结构不清晰, 意义欠连贯。
第一档 (0 分)	—未作答: 所写内容太少或无法看清以致无法评判; —所写内容全部抄自原文或与题目要求完全不相关。

Possible version 1:

Their words made Messi start to consider the true meaning of a real soccer player. With their remarks echoing in his mind, he ultimately began to comprehend that posing with a ball and just cheering for others couldn't make a real soccer player. The thought was an invisible motivation that urged him to practise. The subsequent days witnessed his early rising and dedicated training. He practised how to kick, throw the ball in from the sideline and how to pass the ball to his teammate. As time elapsed, his devotion was rewarded and he became a skilled player. (83 词)

Finally, it came the last game of the season between the Green Lightning and the Golden Sun

again. Messi could not wait to demonstrate that he could be a real soccer player. Therefore, he played actively when the game kicked off. He chased the ball up and down and finally took control of the ball. Abruptly, he kicked it hard and passed it right to one of his teammates who scored. At length, The Green Lightning was the winner of the game and Messi won the cheer from all his teammates and his coach. At this juncture, Grace approached him, acclaiming, “you are the real soccer player.” Hearing this, Messi felt on top of the world, with a victorious smile on his face .(107 词)

Possible version 2:

Their words made Messi start to consider the true meaning of a real soccer player. “Without the intense training to better the football skills, the so-called serious game face and victory smile would be nothing but a ‘ridicule’”, thought Messi. Thus, he spared no effort to practice kicking the ball, running after it and kicking it again attentively and painstakingly, regardless of wind or rain, often the beads of sweat blurring his vision but the goal in his mind becoming much clearer. Every time he felt worn out and exhausted, the words of Grace and Coach Jupiter would linger in his head, which undoubtedly lifted his spirits and pushed him to rise to his feet again. Day after day, Messi felt his muscles strengthened and his skills perfected, everything in good conditions. (117 词)

Finally, it came the last game of the season between the Green Lightning and the Golden Sun again. Thinking of all the endeavor he had made for the game, Messi, fully-prepared and confident, took a deep breath and stepped into the soccer field. Instead of chasing the ball up and down aimlessly, this time, he demonstrated his excellent running kick and long pass, which helped the Green Lightning take over the game. Heart pounding wildly, he kept on running as fast as he could, and finally here came the chance! Everyone present held their breath and later, the field exploded with thunderous applause. GOAL! All the teammates ran to him thrillingly and threw him into the sky with deafening cheers, while Messi showed his victory smile spontaneously. (109 词)
