Sample of the Summary Writing:

Western painting mainly consists of the Middle Ages, the Renaissance, Impressionism and Modern art. Paintings in the Middle Ages were full of religious themes while those of the Renaissance pay more attention to humans rather than religion. The impressionists' paintings were painted quickly and not so detailed so they were controversial, but they were the beginning of the Modern art, some of which are abstract while some are so realistic that they look more like photographs.
