【续写要点】

①由第一段首句内容“Eric 跑向他的新朋友”可知,续写应围绕 Eric 如何满足残疾男孩 Jerry 的愿望进行描写,为和后文首句呼应,飞翔男孩 Eric 一定要背起残疾男孩 Jerry,内容要涉及到两个小男孩的语言、动作和神态描写。

②由第二段首句内容“Eric 背着 Jerry 越跑越快”可知,续写应该围绕 Eric 背着残疾男孩 Jerry 快乐地奔跑和飞翔进行描写也可以加上父亲的感受。重点突出友情。

若续写情节与开头语有明显的冲突,须按评分标准适当扣分;总词数少于 150 的,从总分中扣去 2 分。

阅读理解:

A 篇

21. A 细节理解题。由第一段 Sunrise Magic offers sunrise flights 365 days a year.可知 Sunrise Magic all year round 全年营业。

22. B 细节理解题。由 Flight cost: \$180 per person (Children under 12 -\$120)可知夫妇俩带一个 11 岁孩子,最少需要花费 480 美元。

23. D 细节理解题。由最后一段最后一句可知天气情况不允许飞行的话,乘客可获得全额退款。

B 篇

24. D 细节理解题。结合第二段尾句和第三段首句可知她改变职业的目的是为了寻求人生意义,她利用即将过期但依然在安全食用期内的食物帮助那些需要帮助的人,同时减少了浪费。

25. B 细节理解题。从第二、三、四段可知, Manning 创立了 KiwiHarvest, 将即将过期但依然在安全食用期内的食物提供给食物短缺的人,即减少了浪费,也有利于环保,公司规模也由一人发展为在全国有多家分公司的连锁组织。

26. A 推理判断题。根据文章第五段可知,她努力去解决食物浪费并帮助食物短缺的人为她赢得了 2022 Kiwibank New Zealand Local Hero of the Year Award。

27. C 推理判断题。根据文章最后一段可知,接下来 KiwiHarvest 将进入社区,主要通过讲述她们的故事教育人们节约粮食,健康饮食。

C 篇

28. C 细节理解题。由第二段可知 AR 指的是通过电子设备将数字信息叠加在真实世界信息之上,实现“无缝”集成的技术,目标是在屏幕上把虚拟世界套在现实世界并进行互动。电子设备可以是一副智能眼镜、一台平板电脑,甚至是一部智能手机。与“虚拟现实”不同,用户可以在这个数字世界中触摸物体并四处移动,而不是被限制在一个小区域。所以 C 项“使用者可以亲自探索这个数字世界”符合题意。

29. B 推理判断题。根据第三段最后一句可知上述例子都表明 AR 增强了购物者店内体验的感觉,让生活更轻松。

30. A 推理判断题。根据最后一段 Kipman 认为“在 AR 达到巅峰之前,我们还有很长的路要走,回顾这十年,技术的发展阶段就像人类尚处于穴居人阶段一样。”由此推知, Kipman 对 AR 技术的态度谨慎。

31. D 推理判断题。由全文可知 AR 增强了使用者体验,已经应用于很多商业,并有望扩展到更多领域,尽管技术有待完善,但有着相对光明的前景。

D 篇

32. C 细节理解题。根据第一段可知不断变化的时尚诱使人们不断购买新衣服。

33. C 细节理解题。根据第三段第二句话“攒钱购买更高质量、更可持续的服装,多穿几年更环保。”就是 C 项“充分利用性价比高的衣服”。

34. D 猜测词义题。根据第三段可知“胶囊衣橱”是由少量重要的衣物和经典配饰组成，随意组合就能形成不同的搭配，时尚又环保。statement pieces 指点睛单品。

35. A 主旨大意题。通读全文可知，本文主要介绍了随着时代的发展，人们一味地追求时尚，不断购买新衣服，既造成了浪费，又不环保。对此，作者提出了既能追求时尚又环保的一些方法。所以 A 项“时尚可以跟上可持续发展的步伐”是作者想要表达的意图。
