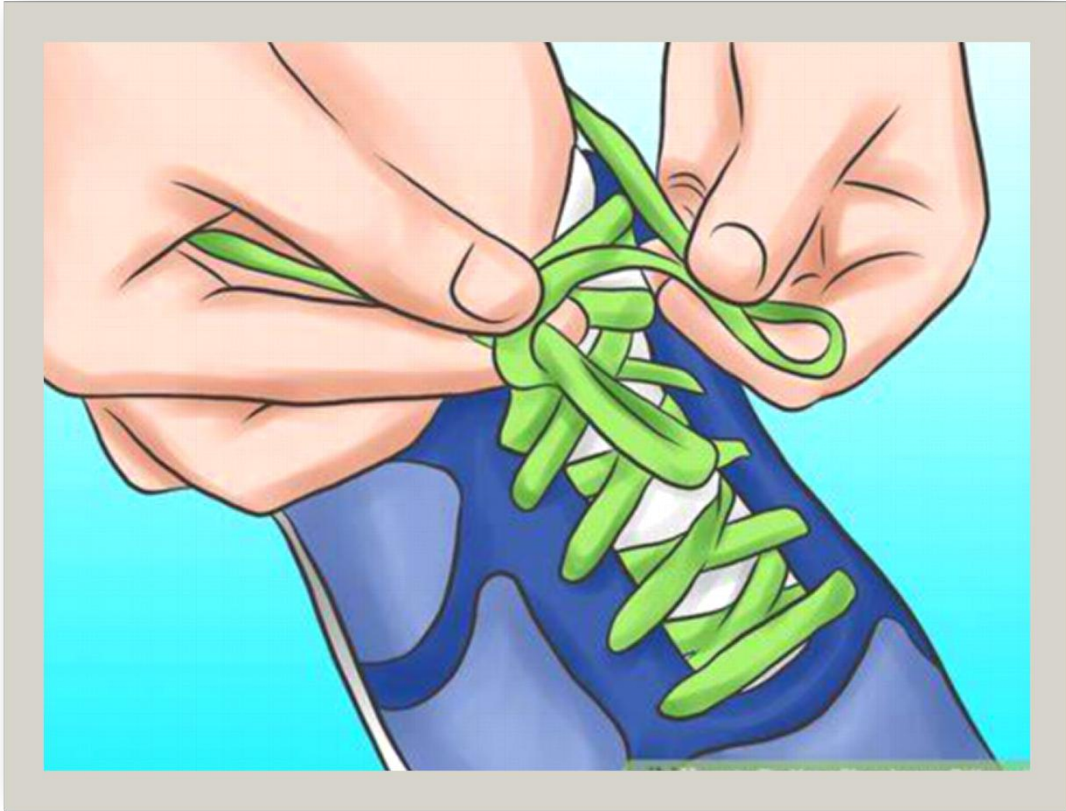

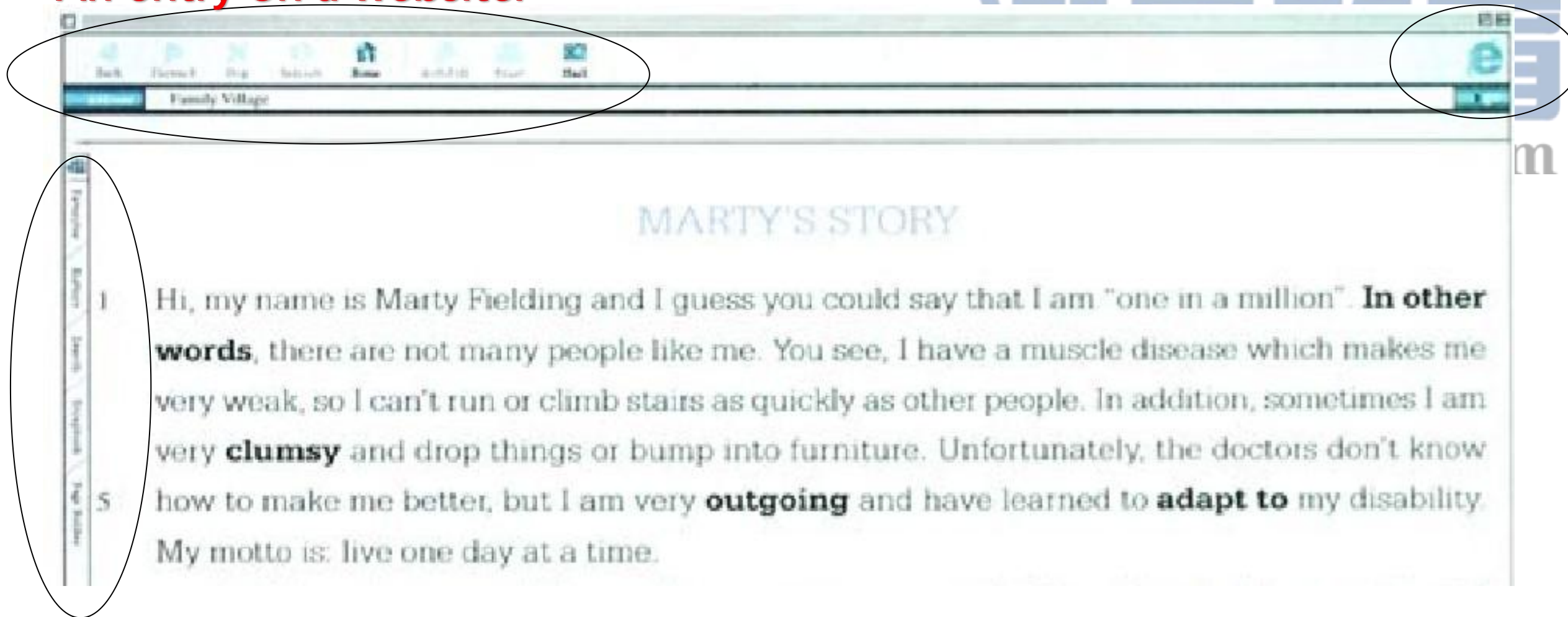

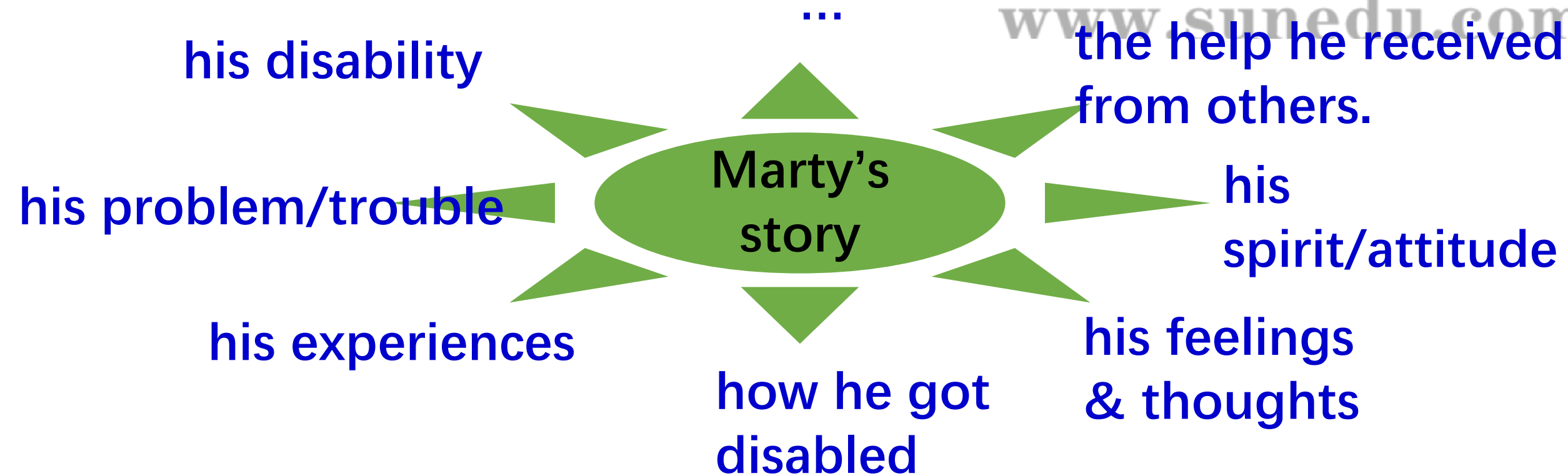

## His good life

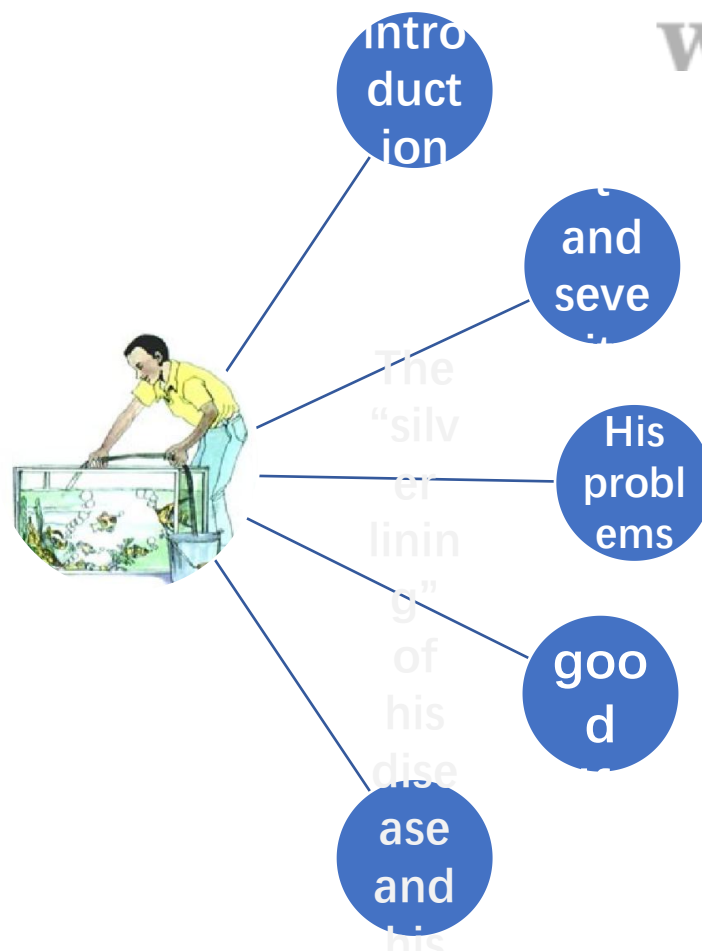

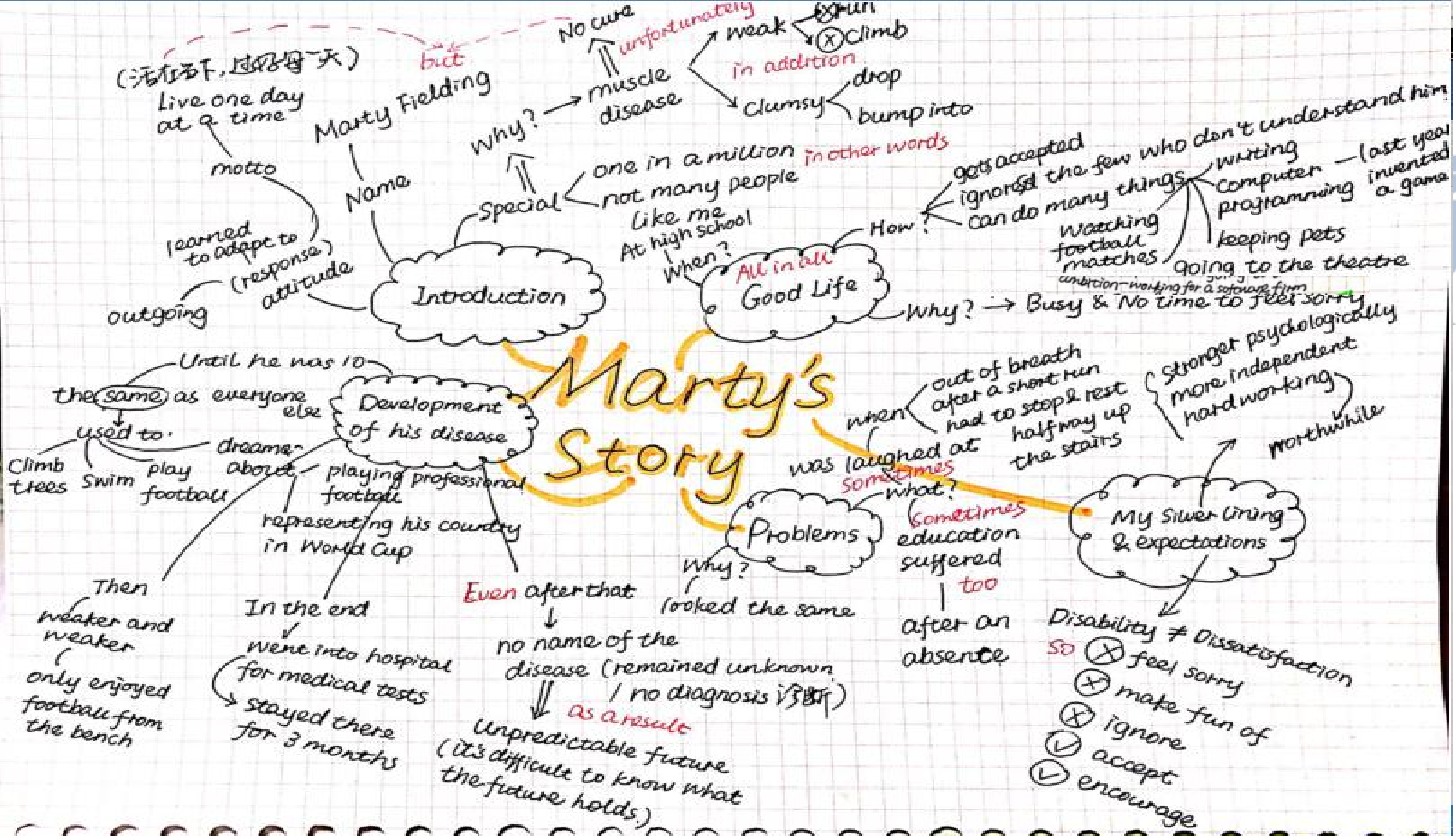


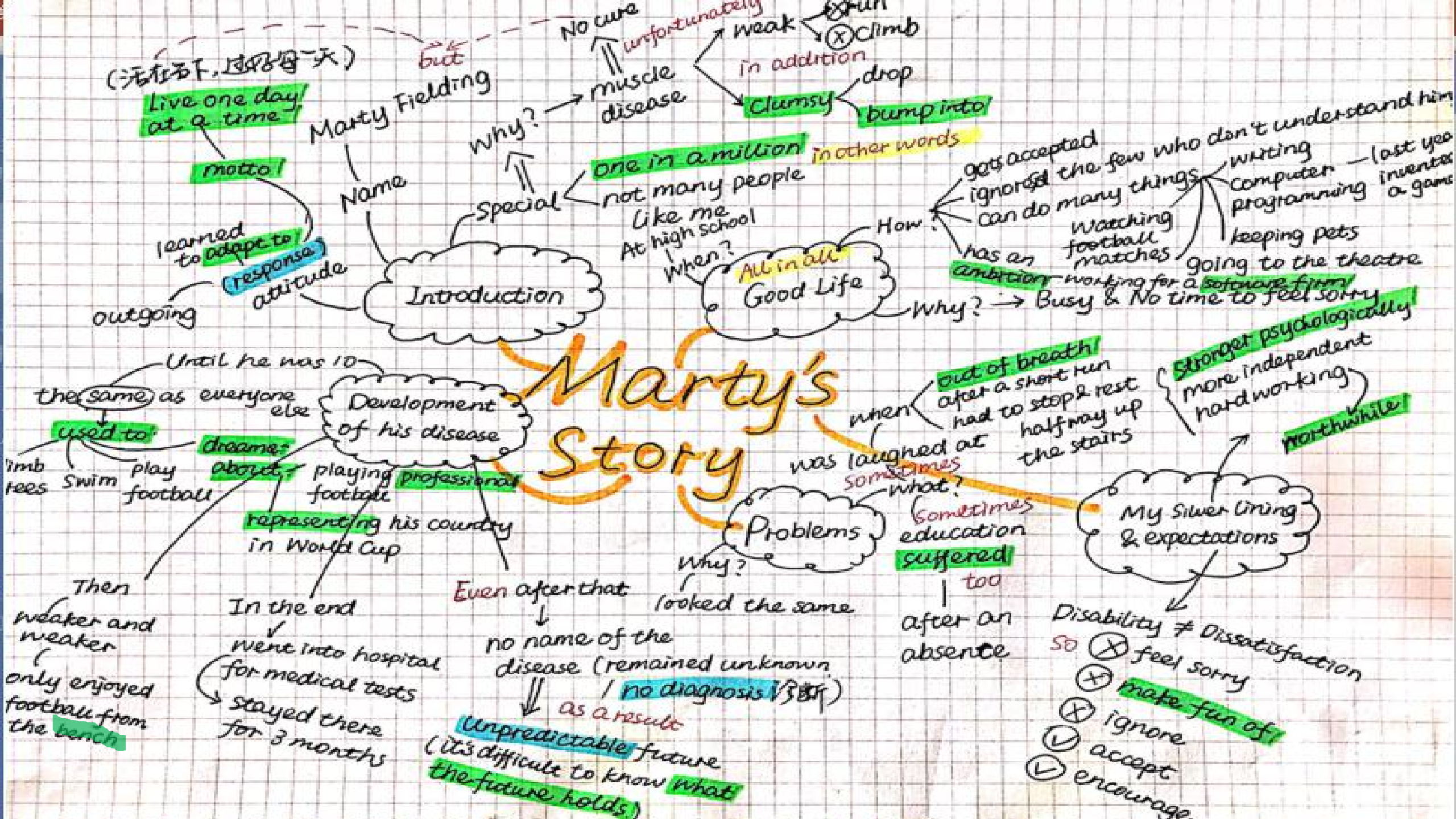
