I buy you lunch and you fix my computer. Is that a fair exchange? 我请你吃午饭, 你给我修计算机, 这算是公平交易吧?

educational exchanges for young people 面向年轻人的教育交流

Everyone in the group exchanged email addresses. 所有的组员都相互交换了电子邮件地址。

They sold eggs in exchange for salt and tea. 他们把鸡蛋卖掉换取茶叶和盐。

Linda teaches me French in exchange for Chinese lessons. 琳达教我法语, 作为交换我教她汉语。

exchange sth with sb. 与某人交换某物

I exchange learning experience with my classmates. 我与同学交流学习经验。

I shook hands and exchanged a few words with the manager. 我与经理握手, 相互交谈了几句。

exchange A for B 把 A 换成 B

If you are not satisfied with the car, you can always exchange it for another. 如果你对车不满意, 可以随时另换一辆。

I am going to America next week, so I have to exchange some RMB for dollars. 我下周要去美国, 所以得把人民币兑换成美金。

Did you ever lecture at Harvard? 你在哈佛大学开过讲座了吗?

I was asked to lecture on Chinese literature yesterday. 昨天我应邀去讲中国文学。

a lecture on/about sth 关于……的讲座/训斥

Smith gives lectures on business management. 史密斯教工商管理课。

I know I should stop smoking—don't give me a lecture about it. 我知道我该戒烟, 别再训斥我了。

lecture sb about/on sth 因某事指责/训斥某人

He's always lecturing me about the way I dress. 他对我衣着总是指手画脚的。

He used to lecture me about drinking too much. 他以前常唠叨我喝酒太多。

He's a lecturer in French at Oxford. 他是牛津大学的法语讲师。

The lecturer spoke very clearly so that we could hear every word. 演讲者讲话很清楚, 我们每个字都能听清。

We registered his birth. 我们给他进行了出生登记。

register for 为.....注册/登记

We have to register for classes on Friday. 我们必须在星期五去注册课程。

She will register for the physics class. 她准备选修物理课.

registration /ˌredʒɪ'streɪʃn/ n. 登记; 注册; 挂号

in the registration office 在登记处 (P2)

The registration of students for the course will begin on Thursday morning. 学生登记上的这门课将于星期四上午开始。



Lin Zexu and Yue Fei are our national heroes. 林则徐和岳飞是我们的民族英雄。



7. design /dɪ'zain/ n.设计; 方案; 图案

She came to London in 2019 to study fashion design. 她 2019 年来到伦敦学习时装设计。

The shoes were of good design and good quality. 这些鞋样式新颖, 质量上乘。

They drew up the design for the house in a week. 他们在一周内就画出了房子的图样。

by design= on purpose 故意地

I am sure he did it by design. 我肯定他是故意做的。

We don't know if it was done by accident or by design. 我们不知道那是偶然的还是故意的。

vt.设计; 筹划

design a car/a dress 设计汽车/连衣裙

This bridge was designed by Scott. 这座桥是斯科特设计的。

My brother is a fashion designer. 我哥哥是一名时装设计师。



8. campus/'kæmpəs/n.校园, 校区

词根词缀: camp(营地)+us(我们): 我们的营地——校园, 校区

on (the) campus 在校园里

An exchange student is talking to a teacher on campus. 一个交换生正在校园里和一位老师谈话。(P3)

They spoke of the old days on the campus. 他们谈起昔日的校园生活。

The campus of Harvard University is very beautiful. 哈佛大学的校园非常漂亮。

The campus covers an area of twenty square kilometers. 这个校园占地二十平方公里。



9. formal /'fɔ:ml/ adj.正式的; 正规的

People speak in a more polite way in formal situations. 在正式场合人们说话更礼貌。(P3)

He wrote a very formal letter of apology to Mary. 他给玛丽写了一封非常正式的道歉信。

They had a formal dinner after the play. 演出结束后他们举行了一个正式的晚宴。

He didn't have any formal dance training. 他没受过任何正规的舞蹈训练。

formally /'fɔ:m əli/ adv.正式地; 正规地

We need to dress formally for the party. 我们需要穿得正式参加晚会。

Everyone was formally lined up to meet the king. 大家正式地排队迎接国王。

informal /ɪn'fɔ:ml/ adj. 非正式的; 非正规的

an informal meeting/visit 非正式的会议/访问

The house has an informal atmosphere. 房间里有一种轻松随意的氛围。

I would like it to be an informal occasion. 我希望把它办得不那么正式。

informally/ɪn'fɔ:məli/adv.非正式地

They told me informally that I had got the job. 他们非正式地告诉我我已获得那份工作。

The guests were seated very informally around the table. 客人们很随意地坐在桌旁。



10. anxious /'æŋkʃəs/ adj. 焦虑的; 担忧的; 渴望的

an anxious look/face/expression 忧虑的目光/面容/表情

Tom is a very anxious person. 汤姆是个非常容易焦虑不安的人。

be anxious about sth. 为某事焦虑

He seemed anxious about the meeting. 他似乎对这次会议忧心忡忡。

be anxious for sb. 为某人担忧

Parents are naturally anxious for their children. 父母自然为儿女担心。

be anxious to do sth. 渴望做某事

She was anxious to finish school and get a job. 她渴望毕业找一份工作。

anxiously /'æŋkʃəslɪ/ adv. 焦急地

He is anxiously waiting for the result of the medical tests. 他焦急地等待着体检结果。

I hope for her letter anxiously. 我焦急地盼望着她的回信。

anxiety /æŋ'zaiəti/ n. 焦虑; 忧虑; 渴望

Her voice was full of anxiety. 她的声音满是焦虑不安。

Anxiety is modern man's natural state. 焦虑是现代人的自然状态。

He shouted at her with anxiety. 他焦急万分地对着她大喊大叫。

Tom's anxiety to succeed led him to work hard. 汤姆对成功的渴望使他更加努力。

11. annoy /ə'nɔɪ/ vt. 惹恼, 使恼怒

She sometimes does things on purpose just to annoy me. 她有时存心做些事来使我生气。

A fly was annoying him. 一只苍蝇搅得他心烦。

It annoyed me that I didn't have time to do more reading. 腾不出时间多看会儿书让我很烦。

annoying /ə'nɔɪŋ/ adj. 令人恼怒的, 恼人的

Don't ask lots of annoying questions. 不要问许多烦人的问题。

You must have found the children annoying. 你肯定觉得这些孩子讨人厌烦。

It is annoying that there is no hot water. 没有热水, 真烦人。

annoyed /ə'nɔɪd/ adj. 感到恼怒的, 生气的

Her mother was annoyed because she was so late. 她母亲生气了, 因为她来晚了。

He was annoyed to learn that the train would be delayed. 他得知火车要晚点, 心里感到烦恼。

be annoyed with sb (at/about sth) (因某事)对某人恼火

He was very annoyed with me about my carelessness. 因为我粗心大意, 他对我恼火了。

12. fright /fraɪt/ n. 惊吓, 惊骇

I got the fright of my life. 我吓得要命。

with/in fright 惊恐地; 被吓得

Pinocchio was beginning to tremble with fright. 皮诺乔开始吓得浑身发抖。

The birds smashed into the top of their cages in fright. 鸟儿们吓得猛撞笼顶。

The grandmother jumped up in her fright and asked him what that meant. 奶奶吓得跳起来, 问他这是怎么回事。

frighten /'fraɪtn/vt. 使惊恐; 吓唬

Sorry, I didn't mean to frighten you. 对不起, 我没有吓唬你的意思。

Most children are frightened by the sight of blood. 大多数孩子见到血就害怕。

frightened /'fraɪtnd/ adj. 受惊吓的; 感到害怕的

a frightened child 受了惊吓的小孩

She was frightened that the plane would crash. 她害怕飞机会坠毁。

Her frightened face showed us that something terrible had happened to her family. 她惊恐的神色向我们表明她家出了大事。

be frightened of (doing) sth. 害怕(做)某事

She was frightened of flying. 她害怕坐飞机。

I'm frightened of walking home alone in the dark. 我害怕在黑夜单独走路回家。

be frightened to do sth. 不敢做某事

She was too frightened to tell her family what had happened. 她太害怕了, 不敢告诉家人发生了什么事。

frightening /'fraɪtnɪŋ/ adj. 令人恐惧的; 吓人的

a frightening experience/thought 可怕的经历/想法

The idea of death is frightening to most people. 死的想法对于大多数人都是可怕的。

It's frightening to think it could happen again. 想到此事可能再次发生就使人不寒而栗。

13. senior /'si:nɪə(r)/ adj. (级别、地位等) 较高的; 年长的 n. 较年长者**senior high school (美国) 高中**

So this is it— senior high school at last! 就是这样——终于上了高中! (P4)

a senior manager/lecturer 高级经理/高级讲师

a senior post/position 高级职务/职位

senior to sb. 比某人资格高/年长

He is senior to me. 他的职位比我高。

Williams felt himself to be senior to all of them. 威廉斯自认为比他们所有人资格都要老。

My brother is my senior by two years. 我哥哥比我大两岁。

14. at last 终于; 最后

The rainy season has ended at last. 雨季总算过去了。

At last they won their freedom. 他们终于赢得了自由。

His wish to visit China has at last come true. 他要访华的愿望终于实现了。

At first he was very tense and at last relaxed. 起初, 他非常紧张, 最后终于放松了下来。

15. outgoing /'aʊtɡəʊɪŋ/ adj. 外向的; 开朗的

I'm not outgoing so I'm a little anxious right now. 我不外向, 所以我现在有点焦虑。 (P4)

He is an outgoing and lively person. 他是个性格开朗而又活泼的人。

She's friendly and outgoing. 她好相处, 性格外向。

16. impress /ɪm'pres/vt. 使钦佩; 使印象深刻 vi. 留下印象; 引人注目

词根词缀: im-(里)+press(按压): 把……按到心里——留下印象

It impressed me that she remembered my name. 令我佩服的是她记得我的名字。

What impressed me most was their brave spirit. 给我印象最深的是他们的无畏精神。

impress sb with/by sth. 用……给某人留下深刻印象

be impressed with/by 对.....印象深刻

She was deeply impressed by/with the scenery in Guilin. 桂林的景色给她留下了深刻的印象。

impress sth on sb. 把...印在...上; 使铭记

My father impressed on me the importance of hard work. 我父亲要我牢记努力工作的重要性。

The scenery in Guilin never fails to impress. 桂林的景色永远让人叹为观止。

impression/im'preʃn/ n.印象

There was a general impression that tomorrow meant a fresh start. 普遍的感觉是明天意味着一个新的开始。

make/leave a ... impression on sb.给某人留下.....的印象

I want to make a good first impression. 我想给人留下好的第一印象。(P4)

I hope to make a good impression on your family. 我希望给你的家人留下个好印象。

Her words left a lasting impression on me. 她的话给我留下了难忘的印象。

have/get an impression of 对.....有印象

I have a good impression of him. 我对他有很好的印象。

first impression 第一印象


First impressions are the most lasting. After all, you never get a second chance to make a first impression.

what if 用于疑问句句首, 尤用于询问不希望看到的事发生时的结果。

What if no one talks to me? 如果没人跟我说话怎么办? (P4)

What if it rains? 要是下雨怎么办?

What if anything should happen to the child? 万一这孩子出了差错怎么办?

So what if you make a mistake? 如果你犯了错那又怎样?

18. guy/gai/ n.小伙子; 家伙

I was working with a guy from Japan. 我与一个来自日本的小伙子一起工作。

Hi, guys. How are you doing? 嗨, 伙计们, 大家还好吧?

19. concentrate/'kɒnsntreɪt/vt.& vi.集中(注意力); 专心于; 聚精会神

词根词缀: **con-**(都)+**centr-**(中央)+**-ate**:都集中到中央——集中; 专心; 聚精会神

I haven't been able to get enough sleep, and I'm too tired to concentrate in class. 我睡眠不足, 课上精力不集中。

concentrate on (doing) sth. 集中注意力于(做)某事

I couldn't concentrate on the experiment. 我无法集中精力做实验。(P4)

You should concentrate on food while eating. 吃饭时, 你应该把注意力放在食物上。

Water companies should concentrate on reducing water waste. 自来水公司应该专注于减少水浪费。

concentrate sth. on (doing) sth 把……集中于(做)某事

You should concentrate your energy on reading and writing. 你应该集中精力于阅读和写作。

I decided to concentrate all my efforts on finding a place to live in. 我决定全力以赴找个住的地方。

concentration /ˌkɒnsn'treɪʃn/ n. 集中; 专心, 全神贯注

This book requires a great deal of concentration. 这本书需要全神贯注才能读懂。

With great concentration she worked out the problem. 她聚精会神地解出了这个问题。

20. experiment /ɪk'sperɪmənt/ n. 实验; 试验

do/perform/conduct an experiment 做实验

What do we learn from the experiment? 我们从这个实验中学到了什么?

Many people do not agree to do experiments on animals. 许多人不赞成在动物身上做试验。



21. leave...alone 不打扰..., 不惊动...

I really wanted to tell him to please be quiet and leave me alone! 我真想告诉他请安静点, 别打扰我。(P4)

I've told you before—leave my things alone! 我告诉过你——别碰我的东西!

Leave the birds' nests alone. 不要去碰鸟巢。

22. awkward /'ɔ:kwəd/ adj. 尴尬的; 笨拙的; 棘手的

I didn't feel awkward or frightened at all. 我一点也不觉得尴尬或害怕。(P4)

They were trying to get out of this awkward situation. 他们正设法摆脱困境。

There was an awkward silence in the meeting room. 会议室里一阵令人尴尬的沉默。

She's got to an age where she is being awkward. 她到了难相处的年龄。



23. junior /'dʒuːniə(r)/adj.地位/职位/级别低下的 n.职位较低者;(体育运动中的)青少年**junior high school (美国)初级中学**

I miss my friends from junior high school, but I believe I will make new friends.

我想念我初中的朋友,但我相信我会结交新朋友。

My daughter is 16 and my boy is already in junior high school. 我女儿 16 岁了,我儿子已经上初中了。

We could give the job to somebody junior. 我们可以把这份工作交给职位较低的人。

office juniors 办公室的一般职员

She has coached many leading juniors. 她训练过许多名列前茅的青少年运动员。

junior to sb. 比某人资格低/年青

That teacher's assistant is at least ten years junior to the professor in experience.

24. explore /ɪk'splɔː(r)/vt.& vi.探索, 探测; 勘探

词根词缀: ex-(外)+plo-(应用)+re(反复): 反复到外面去找有用的东西——探索, 探测; 勘探

I believe I will make new friends here, and there's a lot to explore at senior high. (P4)



The team feels confident of winning. 这个队觉得有把握取胜。

be confident that...确信……

I'm confident that you will get the job. 我肯定你能得到那份工作。

confidently/'kɒnfədəntli/adv.确信地; 肯定地; 自信地

You must act confidently. 你必须表现得自信。

He felt safe now, and he spoke more confidently. 他觉得现在安全了, 便更大胆地说起来。

I can confidently promise that this year is going to be very different. 我可以信心十足地保证今年将大不一样。

confidence /'kɒnfɪdəns/n.信心; 信任; 自信心

He expressed his confidence that they would win. 他显示了自己的信心: 他们必定取胜。

He gained confidence when he went to college. 他上大学后增强了自信。

have confidence in 对……有信心/信任

I have every confidence in my students' abilities. 我完全相信我的学生的能力。

We have confidence in our government. 我们对政府充满信心。

with confidence 自信地; 有把握地

He answered the questions with confidence. 他自信地回答了那些问题。

I can say with confidence that the economy will be better soon. 我可以有把握地说经济很快就会好转。

**26. forward /'fɔ:wəd /****adv. (also forwards) 向前**

He took two steps forward. 他向前走了两步。

They ran forward to welcome her. 他们跑向前去欢迎她。

adj. 向前的; 前进的 (只用于名词前)

the forward movement of history 历史的向前发展

the plane's forward door 飞机前舱门

look forward to (doing) sth. 盼望/期待(做某事)

Tom is looking forward to meeting the new exchange student. 汤姆期待着见到新来的交换生。(P6)

We are looking forward to the coming of spring. 我们正盼望着春天的到来。

I look forward to your reply 我期待你的答复。

I look forward to hearing from you in the near future. 我盼望着不久收到你的信。

How does Li Ming organise his thoughts? 李明是如何组织他的想法的？（P7）

to organize a meeting /party /trip /competition /club 组织筹备会议/聚会/旅行/比赛/俱乐部

We'll organize some students into the basketball team. 我们将组织一些学生参加篮球队。

Workers have the right to organize trade unions according to law. 劳动者有权依法组织工会。

His speech is well organized. 他的演讲很有条理。

It's the first time farmers have decided to organize. 这是农场主首次决定组织起来。

He has the ability to organize. 他很有组织才能。


