Tips:

1. 在一个段落中, 通常 but 后的内容是该段落的主题。 但有的时候, but 或 while 的前后内容会是陈述一件事情的两个方面, 那么在写概要时, 两个方面都要涉及。

2. 要学会分析句间关系。如果前后两句话表达的内容几乎相同,或后一句是前一句的解释,那么概要写作时,只要保留第一句话的内容就可以。

Tips:

3. 在写概要时,需要对原句的信息进行整合提炼。如在表达为什么敏感的人更容易与别人有 deeper connection 的时候,可以把两点原因进行整合提炼,即:有同理心(empathy)及对别人的关爱(sincere care)。
