第一节:应用文写作(满分15分)

- 一、评分原则
- 1. 本题总分为15分,按5个档次给分。
- 2. 评分时,先根据文章的内容和语言初步确定其所属档次,然后以该档次的要求来衡量、确定或调整档次,最后给分。
- 3. 词数少于60和多于100的,从总分中减去2分。
- 4. 评分时,应注意的主要内容为:内容要点、应用词汇和语法结构的丰富性和准确性及上下文的连贯性。
- 5. 拼写与标点符号是语言准确性的一个方面,评分时,应视其对交际的影响程度予以考虑。英美拼写及词汇用法均可接受。
- 6. 如书写较差,以至影响交际,将分数降低一个档次。
- 二、各档次的给分范围和要求

档次	描述
第五档 (13~15 分)	完全完成了试题规定的任务。 •覆盖所有内容要点; •应用了较多的语法结构和词汇; •语法结构或词汇方面有些许错误,但为尽力使用较复杂结构或较高级词汇所致; •具备较强的语言应用能力; •有效地使用了语句间的连接成分,使全文结构紧凑; •完全达到了预期的写作目的。
第四档 (10~12 分)	完全完成了试题规定的任务。 • 虽漏掉 1、2 个次重点,但覆盖所有主要内容; • 应用的语法结构和词汇能满足任务的要求; • 语法结构或词汇方面应用基本准确,些许错误主要是因尝试较复杂语法结构或词汇所致; • 应用简单的语句间连接成分,使全文结构紧凑; • 达到了预期的写作目的。

第三档 (7~9 分)	基本完成了试题规定的部分任务。 • 虽漏掉一些内容,但覆盖部分主要内容; • 应用的语法结构和词汇能满足任务的要求; • 有一些语法结构或词汇方面的错误,但不影响理解; • 应用简单的语句间连接成分,使全文内容连贯; • 整体而言,基本达到了预期的写作目的。
第二档 (4~6分)	未恰当完成试题规定的任务。 •漏掉或未描述清楚一些主要内容,写了一些无关内容; •语法结构单调、词汇项目有限; •有一些语法结构或词汇方面的错误,影响了对写作内容的理解; •较少使用语句间的连接成分,内容缺少连贯性; •信息未能清楚地传达给读者。
第一档 (1~3 分)	未完成试题规定的任务。
0分	未能传达给读者任何信息:内容太少,无法评判;写的内容均与所要求内容无关或所写内容无法看清。

- 2. 评分时,先根据所续写短文的内容和语言初步确定其所属档次,然后以该档次的要求来衡量,确定或调整档次,最后给分。
- 3. 词数少于130的,从总分中减去2分。
- 4. 评分时,应主要从以下四个方面考虑:
 - (1) 与所给短文的开头语衔接程度;
 - (2) 内容的丰富性和对所标出关键词语的应用情况;
 - (3) 应用语法结构和词汇的丰富性和准确性;
 - (4) 上下文的连贯性。
- 5. 拼写与标点符号是语言准确性的一个重要方面,评分时,应视其对交际的影响程度予以考虑。
- 6. 如书写较差以致影响交际,可将分数降低一个档次。

二、各档次的给分范围和要求

档次	描述
第五档 (21-25)	 与所给短文融合度高,与所提供的各段落开头语衔接合理。 内容丰富,应用了5个以上短文中标出的关键词语。 所使用语法结构和词汇丰富、准确,可能有些许错误,但完全不影响意思表达。 有效地使用了词语间的连接成分,所续写短文结构紧凑。
第四档 (16-20)	 与所给短文融合度较高,与所提供的各段落开头语衔接较为合理。 内容比较丰富,应用了5个以上短文中标出的关键词语。 所使用语法结构和词汇较为丰富、准确,可能有些许错误,但不影响意思表达。 比较有效地使用了词语间的连接成分,所续写短文结构紧凑。
第三档 (11-15)	 与所给短文关系较为密切,与所提供的各段落开头语衔接有一定程度衔接。 写出了若干有关内容,应用了4个以上短文中标出的关键词语。 应用语法结构和词汇能满足任务的要求,虽有一些错误,但不影响意思表达。 应用简单的句间连接成分,使全文内容连贯。
第二档 (6-10)	 与所给短文关系有一定关系,与所提供的各段落开头语衔接有一定程度衔接。 写出了一些有关内容,应用了3个以上短文中标出的关键词语。 语法结构单调,词汇项目有限,有些语法结构和词汇方面的错误,影响意思了的表达。 较少使用了句间的连接成分,全文内容缺少连贯性。
第一档 (1-5)	 所给短文和开头语衔接较差。 产出内容太少,很少使用短文中标出的关键词语。 语法结构单调,词汇项目很有限,有较多语法结构和词汇方面的错误,严重影响意思了的表达。 缺乏句间的连接成分,全文内容不连贯。
0分	白卷,内容太少无法评判或所写内容与所提供内容无关。
