

Some wild animals are dying out because of the loss of their habitats or over hunting. Human beings hunt wild animals without mercy for their meat and fur. The environment is being polluted, which directly causes the extinction of wild species. If we still don't pay attention to the serious situation and don't realize the importance of wildlife protection , we human beings are to suffer a lot!

To protect wildlife is to protect ourselves. Therefore, taking active measures to protect animals becomes urgent. Firstly, we are supposed to et up more nature reserves so that animals can live freely. Besides, people should not be permitted to kill the endangered animals or buy any animals' products. Of course, calling on people to reduce the emissions of carbon dioxide may help. Additionally, laws should be passed to protect wildlife. Above all, telling people to live in peace with wildlife is necessary.
