##### 评分原则

3. 拼写与标点符号是语言准确性的一个方面，评分时，应视其对交际的影响程度予以考虑。英、美拼写及词汇用法均可接受。
4. 如书写较差，以致影响交际，酌情扣 1-2 分。

### 一、评分原则

1. 本题总分为 25 分，按 5 个档次给分。
2. 评分时，先根据所写概要的内容和语言初步确定其所属档次，然后以该档次的要求来衡量、确定或调整档次，最后给分。
3. 词数少于 40 的和多于 80 的，从总分中减去 2 分。
4. 评分时，应主要从以下四个方面考虑：
  - (1) 对原文要点的理解和呈现情况；
  - (2) 应用语法结构和词汇的准确性；
  - (3) 上下文的连贯性；
  - (4) 对各要点表达的独立性情况。
5. 拼写与标点符号是语言准确性的一个重要方面，评分时，应视其对交际的影响程度予以考虑。
6. 如书写较差以致影响交际，可将分数降低一个档次。

第二档 (6-10)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>— 理解有误差，仅涵盖半数要点。</li><li>— 有些语法结构和词汇方面的错误，影响了意义的表达。</li><li>— 较少使用语句间的连接成分，全文内容缺少连贯性。</li><li>— 出现两句以上整句抄自原文现象。</li></ul>
