At present, we recognize him as one of the world's most famous fashion designers, but he was not always interested in this field. In high school, he was inspired to become a doctor, which led him to apply to the Department of Medicine at the University of Milan. He studied there for three years before deciding to join the army, where he was assigned to the military hospital in Verona. After that, he returned home to work at a men's department store in Milan, and he became familiar with the marketing and designing aspects in clothing.

A friend there convinced him to open up his own design shop in 1973. Two years later, they released a clothing line under the name Giorgio Armani. He began designing women's clothing.

In 1979, he began producing clothing for the United States market. In the early 1980s, he was persuaded to create perfumes for L'Oreal. He also designed the uniforms for the Chelsea Football Club in England, as well as the Italian uniforms for the 2012 Olympics.
