

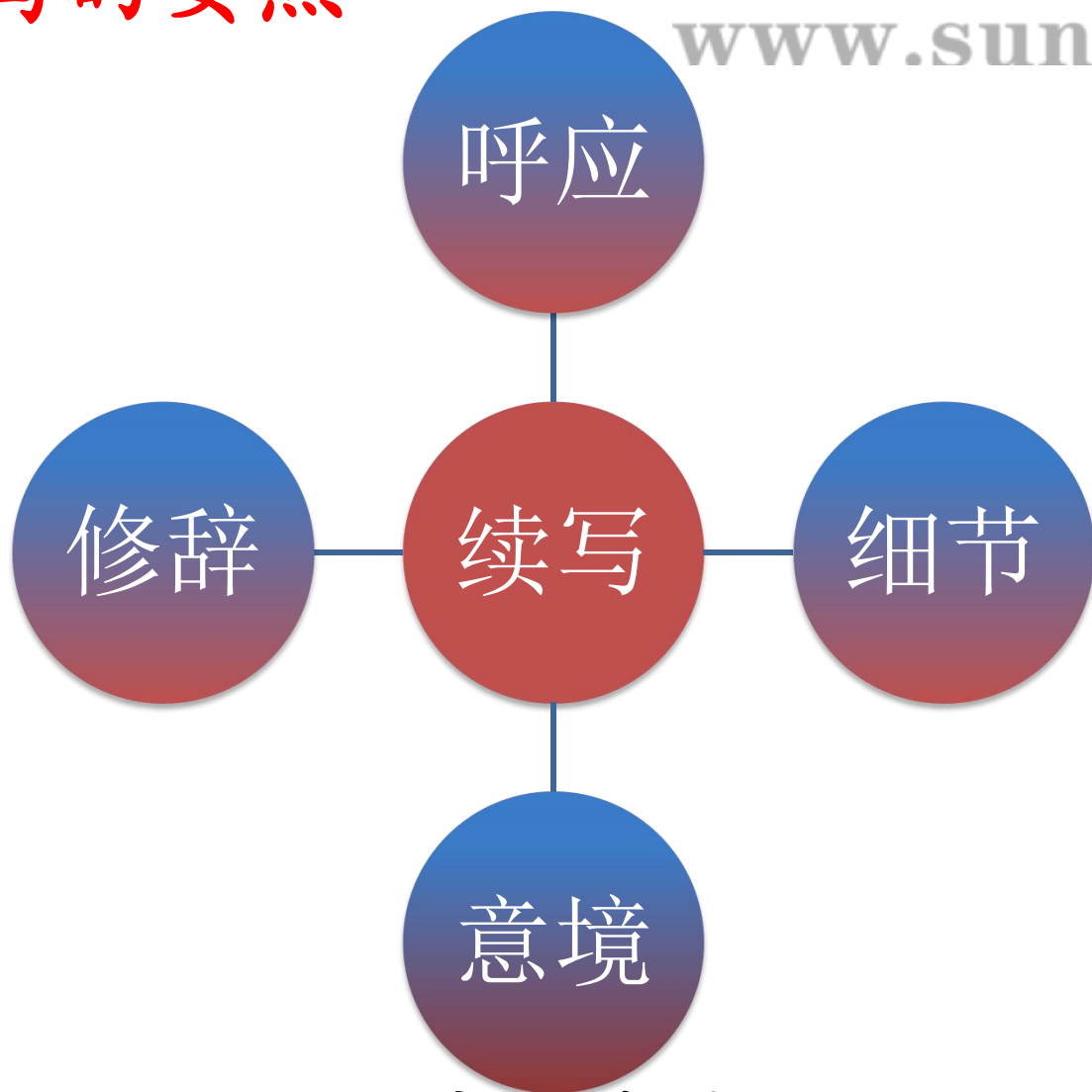

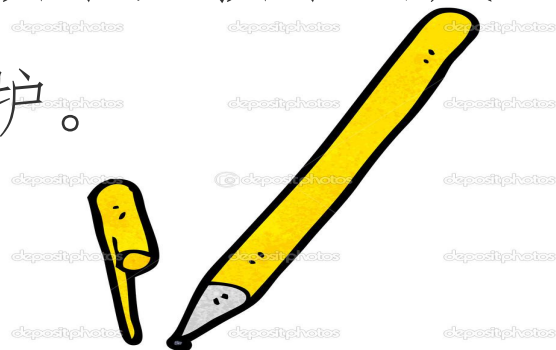
读后续写的要点



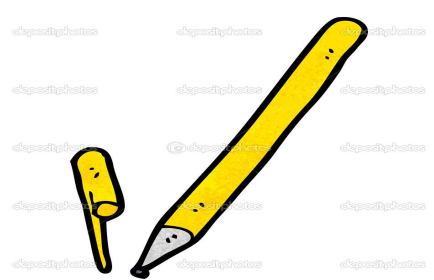
写作是一个结合语言、内容和思维的过程。

写作思路分析

1. **确定主题：**本续写主题是孩子需要父母的陪伴，而父母却忙于工作疏于顾及孩子的情感需求。故事以第一人称的视角进行叙述。讲述的是我由于工作繁忙，没有时间理会女儿需要父亲陪伴的情感渴求，最后女儿因为得不到我的陪伴大哭，女儿的哭声让我明白工作再忙也记得要匀出一点时间去陪伴孩子，孩子的成长不能缺失父母的情感陪伴和心理呵护。

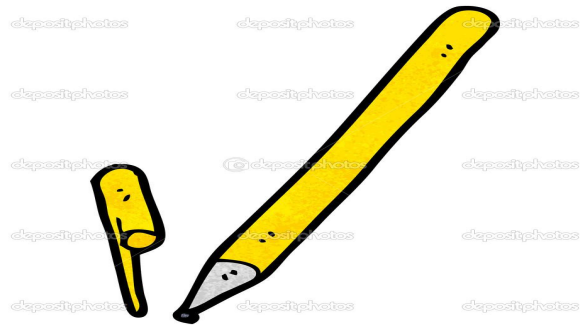


写作思路分析



2. **认知变化:** 妻子出去了, 丈夫留在家一边工作一边照顾幼小的女儿, 丈夫觉得这是一件浪费时间和精力的事 (go against my plan, time-consuming and challenging, sidetracked)。当女儿看到“bib-bibs”, 女儿非常激动 (excitedly, alive with expectation, chatter, leap back, absorbed), 而我心不在焉 (saw myself as a fool, still thought about my work)。当女儿兴奋地抱着她的布娃娃和“bib-bibs”交谈的时候, 父亲觉得这是一个摆脱女儿打扰的好时机 (left them in conversation and returned to my desk)。最后女儿在请求父亲和她出去玩遭到拒绝后大哭 (unfortunately, sob, have no time for her), 此刻父亲才意识到自己的问题。

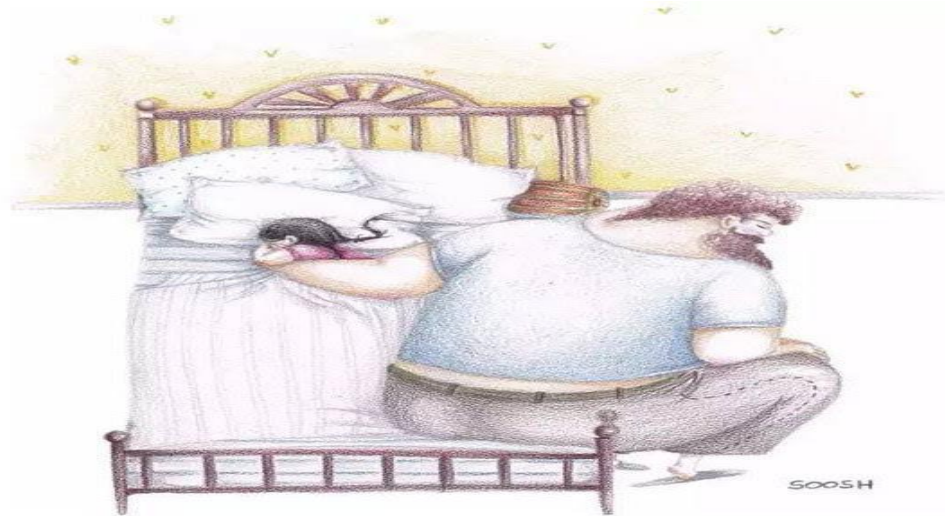


3. 续写难点：该续写的写作有两个难点：一是在第一段女儿提出叫父亲陪她到外面玩，根据第二段的开头句提示，父亲应该是拒绝了女儿的请求，女儿才大哭。要以幼儿（22-month-old）的语言的心理动态去描写，而不是一个大孩子的语气，语气要吻合年龄特征。二是父亲意识到问题后如何安慰幼小的女儿及父亲的感触。
