### Steps to write a good essay

If you ask many people, they will probably say that writing a research paper is challenging. 31

Firstly, choose a topic that you are interested in or a topic you are curious about, which will motivate you to do the necessary research on it. Meanwhile, for helpful and reliable sources of information, the library is the best resource. Use books, published articles, journals, newspapers and magazines to research your chosen topic.

32 Color code them by topic, and use different-colored highlighters to mark the details so you can find each topic easily. Every time you note something down, write the bibliographical(书目的) information, including the author, the book title, page numbers used, volume number, publisher's name and date of publication.

After in-depth research, you can go on to write an outline. With all the notes and important information you've gathered, determine where each topic fits. 33

## 【文章大意】

31. E 考查篇章主旨句。根据上文challenging这个词，以及下文内容，可知本文讲的是basic tips for research.

32. B 考查段落主旨句。观察全文结构，firstly, ...after..., finishing..., once..., 可知本段首句应该是整个写作过程中的第二步；根据空后“color code, mark..., note...”可知，本段讲的是如何系统地做笔记。

33. C 考查上下文的语境理解。根据前文“you can go on to write an outline(写提纲)”、“determine where each topic fits(决定每个话题的位置)”可知，此空应该是：决定论文的框架结构——“note which parts will be the beginning, middle and end.”

34. F 考查上下文的语境理解。根据前文“finishing the outline, you can begin the first draft(写初稿)”。F选项中“**This**”指代的就是写初稿环节。

35. G 考查上下文的语境理解。根据本段段首句：...it is time to write your final draft(写终稿)，再观察空前相似结构“make sure...”“空后”read the final version“，可知G选项符合逻辑和结构。

完形填空

**【文章大意】**

作者去埃及开罗旅游，遇到两个乞讨的孩子。虽然旅游预算吃紧，但作者仍慷慨解囊，给孩子们买了汉堡和巧克力曲奇饼。他们感激不尽，不断地为作者祈祷，却不愿过多接受馈赠。作者由此感悟：物质世界的满足并不能弥补精神世界的匮乏，同情心是通往真善美的钥匙。

**完形填空\*技法点拨****考点类型**

- 1. 语境词汇型：**词汇是完形填空最大考点，主要突显对实词词义的考查，如名词、动词、形容词、副词等，而且设置的四个选项常常是同一词性。
- 2. 习惯搭配型：**在分析语境、理清空白处含义的基础上，利用短语搭配的分析快速准确推断出未知信息。
- 3. 行文逻辑型：**树立语篇概念，抓住文章主旨，理清结构布局，明辨句间/段落间关系，利用句与句/句群与句群之间的逻辑关系解题。
- 4. 语法结构型：**单纯考语法知识的题很少，往往结合语篇理解考查。

**设空特点**

- 1. 完整性：**虽然挖去词/短语，中断了信息链，形成间隔性语义空白，但仍不失为一篇完整的文章。
- 2. 实词性：**完形填空的选项以实词为主，虚词为辅。功能性空格——要求填入连词/介词/冠词；语义空格——要求填入名词/动词/形容词/副词等实义词。
- 3. 同类性：**四个选项基本上属于同一词性/词形。
- 4. 语境性：**根据上下文内容。
- 5. 推理性：**根据上下文提供的信息进行语言逻辑的推理。
- 6. 常识性：**借助常识/背景知识解决，具有边缘学科知识和跨文化思维意识。
