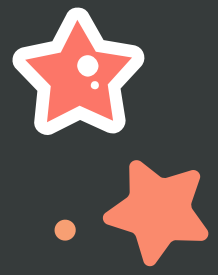

That may prove to be an **underestimate** now. Sales, 63 which stopped in March and April **owing to** effects of the coronavirus, **shifted into 64 a high position** when shops opened and **supply-chain became stable**. In June, Accell, Europe's biggest bicycle manufacturer, earned 53% more than a year ago, **largely thanks 65 to** e-bikes.
